



#### THE RESIDENCES:

The boys and girls residences at BNKIPS are homes away from home. Students spend as much time at the residences as they spend at study or co-curricular activity, and hence set up a link as well as a routine in the way they 'live' at school. At BNKIPS there are 3 categories of boarders:

#### **DAY BOARDERS :**

Under the day boarding concept, the children will have their breakfast, lunch and evening snacks at school. They will reach campus in the morning and leave only by evening after completing their studies, homework, sports, activities and other developmental programs. This would ensure that at the end of the day, the child can spend good quality time with parents and family members, and share his daily experiences.

#### SCHOOL UNIFORMS:

School Uniform School uniform enhances equality among students. Moreover it is an identity of the school. Therefore wearing of uniform is compulsory for students.

#### ACADEMIC YEAR :

The academic session begins from April and continues up to March.

#### **REGISTRATION & ADMISSION**

Registration starts from 2 February. Parents desirous of getting their wards admitted should fill the registration form and deposit at Oneness office.



#### **Medical Facilities and First-Aid :**

The school has first aid facility of its own. Regular medical checkups for the entire school will be done regularly. Cases requiring serious medical attention are taken to the nearest medical hospital.

Reports of any medical examination will be sent to the parents of students who require special treatments. The school will have tie-ups with all the specialist and the students shall be taken to them as required.

The school authorities reserve the right to refer a student to any specialist for treatment or operation when the need arises and when the time is at a premium. In all normal cases, the parents will be consulted first before such action is taken.

#### **Transportation Facilities:**

The school has the bus facility from most of the locations of the nearby Bilagi and Bagalkot. Specially designed buses for the safety and comfort of the students are used. The children are picked and dropped by the escorts. The routes are planned in such a way that the travel time of the children is minimized.

The school is equipped with a professional ground with a kabaddi pitch, kho-kho field, Volley ball.

#### Library :

The library is unrivaled with more than 5000+ books, subscribed latest periodicals and magazines, both Indian and foreign. The students are encouraged to cultivate good reading habits and use the library as an important center for learning.

#### Laboratories :

Large, fully equipped laboratories are there to encourage students to partially explore what they have learnt theoretically and inculcate in them the scientific temper of experimentation and validation. The school has the following laboratories: Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Computer Lab.





#### Mathematics Lab :

The school has a fully functional Mathematics laboratory. The Math lab provides a congenial environment to students to learn and reinforce the concepts with the help of the various instruments.



#### Abacus:

Brain Power abacus classes for students from class III to IX is conducted within the school hours in the school campus to give a child the winning edge, by enhancing the mental ability, listening skills, concentration, memory, speed and accuracy.

#### Computer Lab :

Computers being a plaything for children of the present generation, the computer lab in one of the most sought after lab by the students. The school has a state of the art computer lab with internet facility and a projector with screen. Students learn using individual PCs as well as concepts taught on the big screen via the projector.





#### Dance Studio :

We, at BNKIPS give equal importance to co-curricular activities along with academics. Hence, dance, drama and music are an essential part of the curriculum. The school has a dance studio with three dance teachers who teach all types of dances ranging from classical, hip hop to Bollywood. Filter machines help in providing safe and non-contaminated water to the resident on the campus.

#### School Net:


In school net, the children can navigate the information highway, they can enjoy a real kind of freedom that we never dreamed, could exist.
